Regular Town Board Meeting Tuesday, September 4, 2012 @ 7:00 pm Wascott Town Hall

- Minutes -

Work Session-6:30 p.m.

The work session was called to order by Chairman Greg Jensen at 6:30 p.m. to review financial claims presented for payment by Clerk/Treasurer Atkinson. **A Bush/Stupak motion to adjourn at 6:43 p.m.; carried.**

Regular Board Meeting – 7:00 p.m.

- A. Call to Order/Roll Call – Chair Jensen called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present – Chair Jensen, Supervisors Hanson, Koalska, Stupak and Bush, Clerk/Treasurer Atkinson and 21 guests.
- B. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- C. Approval of Agenda – **A Hanson/Bush motion to approve reversing order of agenda items I.8 and I.9 to discuss I.9 first; carried.**
- D. Approval of Meeting Minutes of August 7, 2012 – **A Bush/Stupak motion to approve; carried.**
- E. Public Comments from persons present – *Bev Allen* – if a decision to open all roads to ATV routes is done, open all at the same time. *Chuck McDermott* responded he does not support opening all roads. This town is following a good procedure – as roads are requested, the town board acts accordingly. *Chuck McCann* commented the 4 Season's Club does not support opening all roads and Chuck personally is not in favor either. *Jan Newsome* – when town roads are opened, needs to be according to ordinance. Asked that the audit recommendations be discussed at a future meeting. *Patti McDermott* – please consider ATV road signage costs if all roads would be opened. *Agnes Kennard* stated she is against opening all roads to ATV routes.
- F. Monthly Reports
 - 1. Reports of Town Officers
 - Supv Hanson* - Sealcoating of designated roads is finished.
 - Supv Bush* – At the last Town Plan meeting, discussed at length the Blasting Ordinance, Non-metallic mining Ordinance, etc. Next meeting Sept 27.
 - Supv Koalska* – Received \$7038 in grant monies for the East and West side Brush Collection Sites. Met with Marty Kasinskis and highway foreman John Lawler on road right-of-way clearing. Meeting with Mark Braasch, DNR Forestry, Tom Mahoney and Bill Matthais will visit the 176 acre park site which has been tagged for tree planting. Sent to Amy Cronk information regarding flood plains and wetlands.
 - Chair Jensen* – The Clerk and I met with the town's insurance agent discussing the upcoming insurance policy coverage. Met with a group of management from Jack Link's beef jerky on Aug 15 regarding a proposed extension of a natural gas line to Minong. This line will follow the Hwy 53 corridor and will come from either Superior to the north or from Trego and go south. Anticipate line to be in within 18 months. The Town Plan Commission did another round of reviewing the Blasting Ordinance, etc. This version was sent to our town attorney for his legal opinion and waiting a reply. At the Conservation & Rec Committee meeting, Sandy Anderson resigned effective immediately, and Terry Hallenback resigned effective Dec 31, 2012. Chair Jensen, on behalf of the board, extended thanks to both members for participating over the last couple of years. Received acknowledgment the town will receive approximately \$12,900 from the Wisconsin Emergency Mgmt Division. Thanked Clerk/Treasurer Atkinson for keeping impeccable records and persistence in furnishing all required documents. Thanked Dave Sletten, DC Emergency Mgmt Dept. for his assistance. Received correspondence from Enbridge indicating the company is requesting a "temporary" driveway permit to access the pipeline for repair work. Chair Jensen asked if there were any further comments from the audience – Patti McDermott commented a "Taste of Wascott" (recipe samplings of the WCC/FDA cookbook) will be held on Sunday, Sept. 16 from 11-1:00 pm at the Town Hall. Free will donation for the Gordon Food Shelf.

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Supv Bush commented he had attended the 4 Season's Food n' Fun event at the ballpark on Sept 1. It was phenomenal. Good food and car show!

2. Fire Department – Chief Michalek reported 3 medical calls, 1 car accident and 1 mutual aid with Solon Springs.
3. EMS-Asst. Director Stacey Vig reported 10 runs-4G/4W/2 Solon Springs. Stacey thanked all who came to the open house. Blood Drive will be Sept 17 at the FD.
4. County Board Representative-Mary Lou Bergman – no report.
5. Northwood School Representative-Michelle Manor – First day of school (9/4). Volleyball and football programs have started for both middle and high school. Sept 27 is September Fest at the Heartwood. HS and middle school initiative will begin and will focus primarily on study skills and will run for 2 weeks.
