Resolution 2011-2
Authorize Grant Application for Red Lake Drive Parking Area

WHEREAS, the Town of Wascott is interested in developing and maintaining a vehicle parking area off of Red Lake Drive, located in T43N-R12W, SE ¼ of SE ¼ Section 25, the 300 ft ROW of the Wild Rivers State Trail, to provide public access to the Wild River Trail recreational trail system,; and

WHEREAS, the proposed parking project is subject to a land use agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR)for the period commencing June 1, 2010, and ending May 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, proposed parking area is eligible for trail aids funding under § 23.09(26) or § 23.33, Wis. Stats.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Wascott shall apply for Outdoor Motorized Recreation Trail Aids for development and maintenance of a recreational parking area off of Red Lake Trail at the location described above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Supervisor Barbara Johnson is authorized to act on behalf of the Town of Wascott to: submit an application to the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for any financial aid that may be available; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the approved project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Wascott will comply with State or Federal rules for the programs to the general public during reasonable hours consistent with the type of facility; and will obtain from the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources approval in writing before any change is made in the use of the project site.

ADOPTED this 8th day of February, 2011, by a majority vote of the Town Board with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given.

Fiscal Note: Upon notification of approval of the application for Outdoor Motorized Recreation Trail Aids, the Town highway department will furnish materials, equipment and labor for the proposed project. Upon completion of work and submission of invoices for project costs, the DNR will reimburse the Town of Wascott.
