Resolution 2014-06
Dedication of Town of Wascott Property at 16365 South Town Hall Road

WHEREAS, the Town of Wascott owns the tract of land in said County of Douglas, Wisconsin, Part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 25, Township 43, North, Range 12 West (16365 South Tow Hall Road, property dimensions 264 ft x 165 ft) as described in Exhibit "A," Douglas County Document #839885 – attached, along with copy of the Quit Claim Deed (Nov 18, 2010), copy of aerial of the property and dimension plat of property and surrounding properties; and

WHEREAS, this property is currently zoned as R-1; and

WHEREAS, this land currently houses the historic Hoffman School House and lends itself to the history of Wascott and an area for tourists to visit, with picnic pavilions, a swing set, and more in the planning stages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Town Board of Wascott hereby dedicates this parcel of land to be held in trust for the public in a manner which ensures the protection and stewardship of the area and natural values associated with the area history; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the park shall be developed for the purpose of preserving the history of Wascott and providing some picnicking, recreation, and tourism attractions.

ADOPTED this 4th day of March, 2014, by a majority vote of the Town Board with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given.
