RESOLUTION # 2002-03

Whereas, by State Statute, a town meeting shall establish the compensation of elective town Offices;

and whereas, by State Statute, the nature of compensation may be: 1) an annual salary, 2) per diem compensation, 3) a combination of (1) and (2), 4) mileage;

and whereas, the townspeople of the Town of Wascott at their December, 1995, Town Budget Hearing set the constable compensation to be by mileage, allowing 100 miles per day;

and whereas, the townspeople have not raised the mileage compensation to date;

and whereas, the Town Board has the responsibility to enforce the will of the townspeople and, therefore, to insure that the constable payment schedule follows the compensation limits set by the townspeople;

Now therefore, be it resolved that, if paid by mileage, the constable must carry a daily mileage log, verified by the town at least monthly;

Be it further resolved that, constable compensation will be limited to the 100 miles per day as established at a legal town meeting;

Be it further resolved that, the constable job is a 12-month job, and, therefore, the payment for any month that the constable is not on duty will remain in the law enforcement budget until the end of the year.
