

Town Meeting Resolution #2008-05
Abolish Position of Elective Town Constable

Whereas, §60.10 (1) (b) 4 of Wis. Stats., authorizes the town meeting to abolish the position of town constable.

Therefore, be it resolved, the special town meeting of the Town of Wascott, Douglas County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the qualified electors of the town, as defined under ch. 6 Wis. Stats., duly assembled and voting, resolves and orders as follows:

Be it resolved, the position of elective town constable shall be abolished commencing with the next elective term.

Be it resolved, that any prior ordinance, resolution or adopted motion in conflict with this resolution is hereby rescinded.

Adopted this 18th day of November, 2008 at a Special Town Meeting.

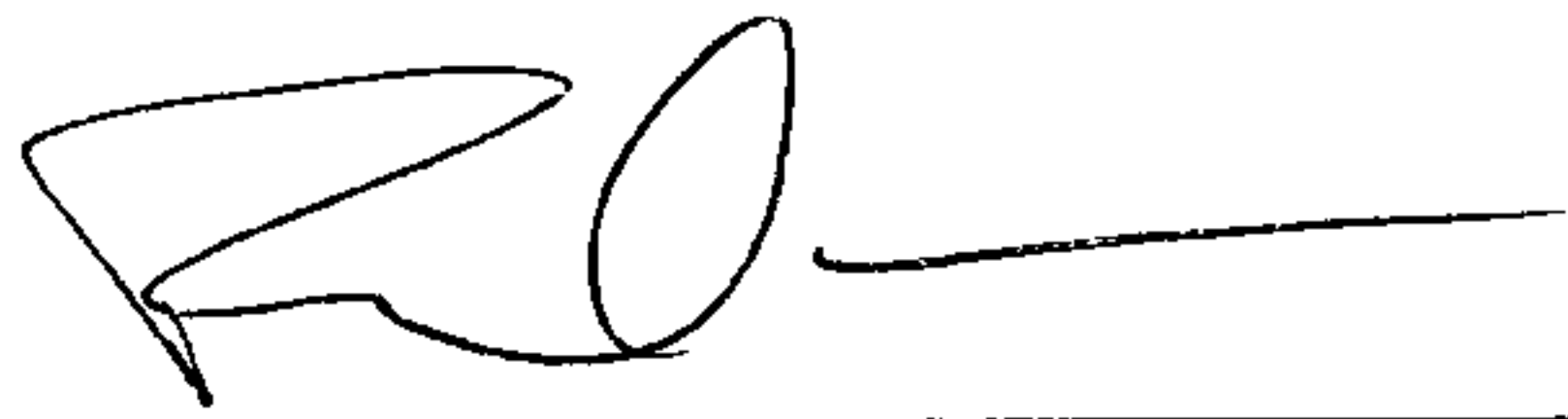
