

Town Meeting Resolution #2008-09
Raise Money, Including Levying Taxes, to Pay for 2009 Town Expenses

Whereas, §60.10 (1) (a) of Wis. Stats., authorizes the town meeting to raise money, including levying taxes, to pay for expenses of the town.

Therefore, be it resolved, the special town meeting of the Town of Wascott, Douglas County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the qualified electors of the town, as defined under ch. 6 Wis. Stats., duly assembled and voting on November 18, 2008, resolves and orders as follows:

Be it resolved, the 2008 tax levy for taxes collectible in 2009 is hereby fixed at the amount of \$ 550,341, as proposed by the Town Board.

Adopted this 18th day of November, 2008 at a Special Town Meeting.

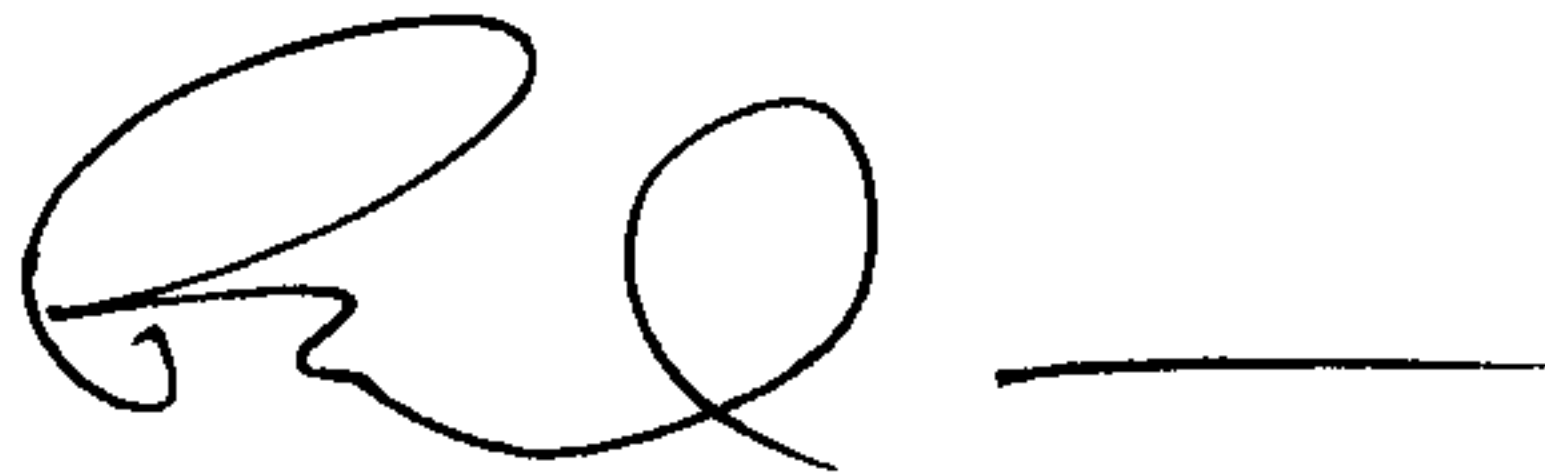
