**Resolution 2009-12  
Authorize Amendments to 2009 Budget**

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats., § 65.90 establishes requirements for municipal budgets, specifies required levels of revenue and expenditure categories, requires a balanced budget, and prohibits any expenditures exceeding the appropriation for a specific purpose at the adopted level of the budget, and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats., § 65.90 (5) (a) further requires that the amounts of the various appropriations and the purposes for such appropriations stated in a budget may not be changed unless authorized by a vote of two-thirds of the entire membership of the governing body of the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of Wascott hereby approves the following amendments to the 2009 budget:

1. Public safety expenditures (#52000) is reduced by \$39,860 and debt service expenditures (#58000) is increased by \$39,860 for correction to the proper category for debt service on fire protection loan payments.
2. Public safety expenditures (#52000) is reduced by \$280,725 and capital outlay (#57000) is increased by \$280,725 for correction to the proper category for capital outlay for fire protection equipment.
3. Public works expenditures (#53000) is reduced by \$37,861 and debt service expenditures (#58000) is increased by \$37,861 for correction to the proper category for debt service on highway maintenance building loan payments.
4. Public works expenditures (#53000) is reduced by \$35,000 and capital outlay (#57000) is increased by \$35,000 for highway capital outlay.
5. Intergovernmental revenues (#43000) is increased by \$10,000 and conservation and development expenditures (#56000) increased by \$10,000 to recognize Cranberry Lake Association grant.
