**Resolution 2010-06
Amendment to Financial Policies**

WHEREAS, the town board adopted resolution 2009-04 establishing financial policies; and

WHEREAS, the town board supports policies and procedures to encourage wise use of tax dollars and to reduce any unnecessary expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the practice of carpooling reduces unnecessary business expenses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that resolution 2009-04 is amended to modify the policy on reimbursement of personal mileage as follows:

“Sec. 24-56. Personal mileage.

Any person using a personal vehicle for business travel shall be reimbursed at the per mile rate established by the IRS. Miles submitted for reimbursement shall be net of any normal commuting miles.

When two or more persons are travelling on town business to the same location/event the participants are expected to travel together in one vehicle whenever practicable. In order to encourage carpooling, the town board may limit mileage reimbursement to the number of drivers it determines to be reasonable.”
