Resolution 2010-28
Elected Official Budget Reductions

WHEREAS, the 2011 budget adopted by the Town Board on November 13, 2010, included significant budget cuts in order to not increase the tax levy and to minimize the use of cash reserves, and

WHEREAS, the budget cuts require changes to Town practices for payments previously made for elected offices.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the following changes shall become effective on January 1, 2011:

- 1) The elected Clerk-Treasurer has the statutory authority to appoint a Deputy Clerk-Treasurer and the appointing authority is responsible to compensate the Deputy. Any Deputy appointed by the elected Clerk-Treasurer shall not be paid by the Town as a town employee.
- 2) The Town of Wascott shall reimburse the elected Town Clerk-Treasurer up to \$250.00 per month for a supplemental health insurance plan.
- 3) Town Board Supervisors shall not receive mileage reimbursement for business-related travel.

ADOPTED this 13th day of November, 2010, by a majority vote of the Town Board with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given.
