

**Ordinance 2009-02**  
**Ordinance to Create 5-member Town Board**

STATE OF WISCONSIN  
Town of Wascott  
Douglas County

**Whereas**, the town board has determined that a five person town board would provide greater representation to the residents of the Town of Wascott and enable the board to more effectively carry out its duties;

**Therefore**, the town board, pursuant to § 60.21 (1), Wis. Stats., elects and ordains to increase the number of town supervisors for the Town of Wascott to 5 members and further ordains that the 5-member town board for the Town of Wascott shall be created as follows:

For the spring election in April 2010, there will be 2 supervisors elected for 2-year terms. Thereafter, at each spring election in odd-numbered years, 2 supervisors and 1 town chairperson will be elected for 2-year terms, and at each spring election in even-numbered years 2 supervisors will be elected for 2-year terms, thereby creating staggered terms pursuant to § 60.21 (1), Wis. Stats.

This ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting by the town clerk as required, pursuant to § 60.80, Wis. Stats.
