

ORDINANCE 2005-01

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE TOWN OF WASCOTT,  
DOUGLAS COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The Town Board of the Town of Wascott, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to section 62.23(2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Wascott is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. The Town Board of the Town of Wascott, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3. The Plan Commission of the Town of Wascott, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board, the adoption of the document entitled "Town of Wascott Comprehensive Plan 2025", containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4. The Town has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 5. The Town Board of the Town of Wascott, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled "Town of Wascott Comprehensive Plan 2025", pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members of the Town Board and publication, as required by law.
