**Ordinance 2024-04**

**Ordinance to Rescind Ordinance 1995-01 – Alcohol Licenses in the Town**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 1995-01-Alcohol Licenses in the Town, defines “Continuing in Business” as follows – Licensee must be open to the public for a minimum of one hundred (100) days in a calendar year, for at least five (5) hours per day; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Revenue Retail Alcohol and Beverage License Division does not restrict nor designate the hours a Licensee must be open for business in a calendar year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Wascott does not have the necessary staffing or resources to enforce this ordinance; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town of Wascott rescinds Ordinance 1995-01 for the following reasons –

- 1) The Town does not have the staffing or resources to enforce the ordinance.
- 2) It is not in the best interest of the Town to restrict or designate the hours a Licensee must be open for business in a calendar year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Wascott hereby rescinds Ordinance 1995-01 and will follow the guidelines as outlined in the Wisconsin Statutes pertaining to operational hours for Licensees.
