Resolution #2000-05

Whereas, within the Town of Wascott there are over 18,000 acres of private forest crop and over 41,000 acres of county forest crop, all of which are being heavily logged,


and Whereas, the Town of Wascott is in need of a good supply of gravel to maintain the approximately 204 miles of town roads that are being very heavily used for logging and wood products transportation,

and Whereas, the only current source of useable gravel in the town is on county land in the Buckley Island area,


and Whereas, the Town of Wascott has been using this area as a gravel pit for at least 18 years,

Therefore, the Town Board proposes a land trade with Douglas County to obtain 10 acres of County land at the Buckley Island location in return for 10 or more acres of town land located in T43N-R11W, Section 1; or if such a trade is not possible, the Town Board proposes the direct purchase of suitable land from the County.




