**Whereas,** the residents of the four properties located on the north side of Alexander Lake have agreed upon the location of a private road providing access to the three interior properties, and that this privately owned road will be located on the existing 66' easement along the north 66 feet of the Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 Certified Survey map Vol. 4 Pages 115-116 located in SW ¼ NE ¼ Section 12 T43N R11W;

**Whereas,** No objections were received by the town to naming this road North Alexander Lake Road;

**and Whereas,** Douglas County Land Records finds no duplication of the name of North Alexander Lake Road in the Town of Wascott;

**Now therefore, be it resolved that,** the Town Board of the Town of Wascott adopts this resolution to name the road North Alexander Lake Road, and to notify the emergency director of Douglas County of said naming.

**Be it further resolved that,** this resolution replaces the previous naming of this road as E Carruthers Road in Town of Wascott resolution# 98-03.

## Resolution #2001-05

**Whereas,** Wisconsin state law requires that town spending may not exceed approved, budgeted amounts in any expenditure category;

**Whereas,** Town of Wascott estimated expenditures for the year 2001 exceed budgeted amounts in some categories, but do not exceed total budgeted expenditures;

**Therefore Be It Resolved** by the Town Board of Wascott as follows:

The budget expenditure amount of \$ ~~8500~~ <sup>5000</sup> is hereby transferred from General Government to Public Safety;

The budget expenditure amount of \$ 300 is hereby transferred from General Government to Culture, Recreation & Education;

The budget expenditure amount of \$ 14 is hereby transferred from General Government to Conservation and Development;

The budget revenue category of Intergovernmental Revenue is increased by \$ 12,482 to reflect a grant from Federal Emergency Management (FEMA).

## Resolution # 2001-04

WHEREAS, Legislation known as "Smart Growth" has been adopted in 1999 as part of Wisconsin Act 9; and

WHEREAS, Smart Growth planning requires that all units of government which provide any regulation/decision which impacts the way land is used must be consistent with an adopted Comprehensive Plan, which must be in place by January 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, A Comprehensive Plan under Smart Growth must address nine elements, which are common to towns, villages, cities and counties; and

WHEREAS, The planning process will involve significant input from year-round and seasonal residents of the township; and


WHEREAS, Anticipated cost to the Town of Wascott is projected to be approximately \$ 10,000.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Wascott commits to completing a Comprehensive Plan upon the successful receipt of state grant funds to support a Smart Growth planning effort.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Comprehensive Plan will be developed at the local level and it is intended that the plan will constitute the Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Wascott.
