ORDINANCE 1-90

LITTER AND DEBRIS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Town of Wascott desires to promote health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public, pursuant to section 61.34 of the Wisconsin Statutes in prohibiting the littering or replacement of debris on property within its jurisdiction, declares such littering and debris placement to be a public nuisance and dangerous to the town;

WHEREAS, litter and debris for the purpose of this ordinance is defined as rubbish, paper, dirt, waste, brush, cans, machinery, tires or timber products.

THEREFORE, The Town Board of Wascott do ordain as follows:

"It shall be unlawful for any person to place, throw, leave or permit to remain any litter or debris upon any street, gutter, sidewalk, alley, park or other public ground and it shall be the duty of each and every owner or occupier of any real property to clear away such litter or debris from all adjacent streets, gutters, sidewalks, or alleys. Further, no person shall place litter or debris or disposal anywhere except at the Gordon-Wascott Transfer Station."

PENALTIES. Any person (s) violating this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture in the amount of \$500.00 plus a penalty assessment and costs.

This ordinance adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Wascott at a regular meeting of the Town Board dated on December 01, 1990 and this ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication to the public.
