Staffed by nationally registered and state licensed Emergency Medical Technicians with the support of skilled Emergency Medical Responder (1st responders). Working in cooperation with all area hospitals and advanced life support helicopter services to provide AFFORDABLE emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

There are two fully equipped ambulances in service 24- hours/day, 7-days/week, 365-days/year. Each ambulance is equipped with an Automatic Defibrillator Unit. Both units are ready for emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

Thank you to the board members, the community, the members of the fire departments (Gordon and Wascott) and all members of the service.

We have added a new 2016 E450 Braun Ambulance to our fleet. (3-14-2016)

2015 Year run totals: 146 runs from Medicals to Fire standby, 69 Gordon, 71 Wascott and 6 were mutual aid to our surrounding communities.
