Providing ambulance service to the residents and visitors of Gordon and Wascott since 1958. Staffed by nationally registered and state licensed Emergency Medical Technicians with the support of skilled Emergency Medical Responder (1st responders). Working in cooperation with all area hospitals and advanced life support helicopter services to provide AFFORDABLE emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

There are two fully equipped ambulances in service 24- hours/day, 7-days/week, 365-days/year. Each ambulance is equipped with an Automatic Defibrillator Unit. Both units are ready for emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

Thank you to the board members, the community, the members of the fire departments Gordon and Wascott and all members of the service.

2017 Year run totals: 146 runs from Medicals to Fire standby, 78 Gordon, 56 Wascott and 9 were mutual aid to our surrounding communities.

Accomplishments for 2017:

- Through donations, grants and the town's we were able to purchase new Cardiac Science G5 AED's (Automated External Defibrillator) for our members, both Ambulances and both town halls.
- Recruiting and retention
 - We have gained 2 new EMT's
- We have added new skills for Emergency Medical Responders (EMR / 1st. Responder), They are now able to do draw up EPI , Blood Sugar Checks, Albuterol and Aspirin. This is a great success for our service thus allowing us to get care to our community even faster.

In 2018 our plan is to:

- We completed our refreshers for 2018 renewal period. Yes we all have to have refreshers every 2 years. This includes skills, medications, CPR and new and updated protocols from the state.
- We would like to add some new training to the service:
 - Street smarts for EMS
 - ALICE - Active Shooter Civilian Response Training for all Organizations
- We will be working on Grants- that help with funding of equipment, supplies and training.
