Providing ambulance service to the residents and visitors of Gordon and Wascott since 1958. Staffed by nationally registered and state licensed Emergency Medical Technicians with the support of skilled Emergency Medical Responder (1<sup>st</sup> responders). Working in cooperation with all area hospitals and advanced life support helicopter services to provide AFFORDABLE emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

There are two fully equipped ambulances in service 24- hours/day, 7-days/week, 365-days/year. Each ambulance is equipped with an Automatic Defibrillator Unit. Both units are ready for emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

Thank you to the board members, the community, the members of the fire departments (Gordon and Wascott) and all members of the service.

2019 Year run totals: 182 runs from Medicals to Fire standby, 86 Gordon, 76 Wascott and 23 were mutual aid to our surrounding communities.

Accomplishments for 2019:

- Refreshers for responders have been completed.
- We have added 2 new members this year, and we have had 3 members move up in licensure.
- Buyback years for Service Award Program and Continuing years.
- Septic System was updated at the base

2020 plan is to:

- Training that will keep us up-to-date in the forever evolving treatment of our patient's.
- We Have added Dementia-Friendly Training to the service, (January 2020)
- Here is our long range plan:
  - Incentives/Recruitment for members
    - Buyback years for Service Award Program and continuing years
  - Monitors x2 one for each Ambulance, these monitors will need to be replaced by 2020
  - Ambulance replaced by 2021
