Mission Statement

Providing ambulance service to the residents and visitors of Gordon and Wascott since 1958. Staffed by nationally registered and state licensed Emergency Medical Technicians with the support of skilled Emergency Medical Responder (1st responders). Working in cooperation with all area hospitals and advanced life support helicopter services to provide AFFORDABLE emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

There are two fully equipped ambulances in service 24- hours/day, 7-days/week, 365-days/year. Each ambulance is equipped with an Automatic Defibrillator Unit. Both units are ready for emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

We have several members who have had achievements of advancing their licensure to the next level of care, some have retired, some have done specific specialty training, and most of all every one of them are here for the community and the visitors. Our run volume for the year 2022 is as follows: 230 runs. Gordon 100, Wascott 90, Fire standby 18 and Mutual aid provided by Gordon-Wascott EMS to our surrounding communities 22.

Every year we apply for grants to help offset the cost of training, equipment and supplies. With these grants and donations from the community members and Local Establishments in the townships of Gordon and Wascott helps us keep our budget dollars down .

We were able to secure grants: in the value of \$ 200,000.00

- ECE Operation Round up, SAMSA Grant, Flex (State of Wisconsin) , Funding Assistant Grant (State of Wisconsin) , ARPA Funds (American Rescue Plan), Embridge Fueling Futures .
- Things that were purchased through these Specific Grants: Propane Generator, Power Load System for the Ambulance Cot, CIT Training (Crisis Intervention Training) , Training Supplies (Training Manikins) , LUCAS Device for CPR, Carbon Monoxide Monitors for Every Member, Time Clock system, Updated Computer Systems, Suction Units, Pediatric Straps , AED/CPR Training and some training classes for members and payroll incentives for members of the service. .
- Thank you to Irene Bott for all the hard work she did in securing these grants. We could not have done this without her dedication to EMS and the Service of Gordon- Wascott.

The New 2022 Ambulance Arrived in early November of 2022 and was put right into service. The old 2007 Ambulance was sold (35,000.00) with the dollars from the sale going back to both the townships of Gordon and Wascott.

With the Full and Part Time Employees working well and the help from some of the grants along with the support of the town's .We are able to this year do a median of volunteer pay for all of the members on the service. This will help us retain the members we have and recruit new members to the service.
